FSCL STATEMENT IN SUPPORT OF EVERGLADES RESTORATION

With two major reservoirs under construction and the most ambitious - an 18,000-acre combination Reservoir and Water Treatment Marsh south of Lake Okeechobee under design - it is exciting to see Florida's Congressional delegation prioritizing the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan (CERP). The bi-partisan energy for something so important to Florida and the country is crucial for its success. We are also encouraged by the actions taken by the Florida Legislature to accelerate important CERP storage and restoration projects north of Lake Okeechobee and the subsequent Congressional authorization of the Lake Okeechobee Watershed Restoration Project.
